With a new buyer in attendance an increased entry of ewes met a greatly improved trade. All grades of ewes were in demand generally an improvement of £10 per head on the previous week. Several pens of strong ewes sold over £50 with an overall average of £41.34. First quality ewes sold from £44. Second quality sold from £30. Small and plain ewes sold to this figure. A short entry of mainly small rams averaged £30.63.

55 REARING CALVES

An entry of 55 rearing calves sold to another good trade particularly on first quality. Top price for young calves was £250 for a Belgian Blue bull with others of the same breed £235 and £208. Charolais bulls to £225, Limousin bulls £224, £198, £188 with Hereford cross bulls £168, £166, £152. A Welsh Black bull realised £165. Heifers to £212, £205 and £192 for Belgian Blues with Charolais £206, £200, £170. Limousin heifers to £160 and Hereford cross £90. 3 month old Simmental bulls to £298 and Heifers £290.

PRE-MOVEMENT TB TESTING

Please note we are holding Green Exempt Markets. This means that fat cattle attending a Green Exempt Market do not need to be pre-movement tested.

This exemption is allowed as cattle are only able to go on to slaughter, back home, onto an approved holding and onto an exempt finishing unit. Dairy cows will still need to be tested.

Calves and Dairy Cows (in Gwilym Richards sale) must be kept separate from the finished cattle, so please make sure cattle are unloaded in the correct part of the market.
