A much improved entry of cattle met another firm trade which was slightly ahead of the previous week. Once again best cattle sold to advantage peaking at 129 pence. A large percentage of the Non-Farm Assured and plainer sorts reduced overall returns. The trade was, nevertheless, ahead of deadweight quotations and more cattle could have been sold to advantage. Premium Steers averaged 110.6p, Prime 98.2p and Others 88.1p. Premium Heifers averaged 112.1p, Prime 100.0p and Others 87.6p. The next Market on MONDAY 17<sup>th</sup> OCTOBER 2005 is a RED MARKET.
