The generally good weather resulted in a seasonally low entry of cattle. The abattoirs have been trying to bring prices back but they have not succeeded as demand far outweighs supply. The entry was again highly variable with a number of leaner cattle reducing overall returns. Meat is definitely required so with corn prices falling it is well worth the investment! The entry was woefully inadequate for the demand with very few Welsh cattle forward. Please keep the entries up as at present deadweight prices are MILES BEHIND!
