First quality ewes sold from £45. Second quality sold from £28. Small and plain ewes sold to this figure. Another short entry of Rams also met an improved trade selling to a top price of £58 with an overall average of £41.05.

47 REARING CALVES

An entry of 47 rearing calves sold to another good trade. Top price was £250 for a Limousin bull with the top for heifers £205 for a calf of the same breed. Belgian Blue heifers keenly sought after with 3 making £200 apiece and other £185, £175, £160, etc. Charolais heifers to £160. Hereford Cross heifers £170. Belgian Blue bull calves to £185. Friesian bulls £70. Hereford Cross bulls £128.

25 DAIRY CATTLE

The strongest trade for several weeks with many buyers going away empty handed. Many more needed to satisfy the demand. Top price was a fresh calved heifer by Painley Knighthood, which sold for £1176 from AR Ractliffe, Haresfield, Glos. Others to £1102.50 and £1029.00. In-calf heifers keenly sought after to £1008 twice. 1st quality averaged £1068.38. 2nd quality average £715.00. In-calf Heifers average £1008.00.

This exemption is allowed as cattle are only able to go on to slaughter, back home, onto an approved holding and onto an exempt finishing unit. Dairy cows will still need to be tested.

Calves and Dairy Cows (in Gwilym Richards sale) must be kept separate from the finished cattle, so please make sure cattle are unloaded in the correct part of the market.

OLDER CATTLE DISPOSAL SCHEME (OCDS)

The above scheme catering for all stock born before 1st August 1996 is now in operation. A fixed headage price of approximately £249.91 (360 euros) before stoppages, will be payable for all animals fit for human consumption. Animals have to be correctly tagged and exactly match their paperwork. We are holding collections on a regular basis on a pre-booked system.
