The large number of overfat ewes reduced the overall average to £34.29. First quality ewes sold from £37. Second quality sold from £24. Small and plain ewes sold to this figure. Another short entry of Rams averaged £33.80.

60 REARING CALVES

An entry of 60 rearing calves sold to an excellent trade on the best quality. Top price was £260 for a Limousin bull calf with others £230. Simmental bulls to £228, Belgian Blue £208, £205 and £180. Hereford cross bulls to £120. Best quality heifers very dear to £242 for Belgian Blue with others of the same breed £240, £235, £220, etc. Charolais Heifers to £175, Aberdeen Angus £130 and small Limousin £130.

FORTHCOMING SALES

PRE-MOVEMENT TB TESTING

Please note we are holding Green Exempt Markets. This means that fat cattle attending a Green Exempt Market do not need to be pre-movement tested.

This exemption is allowed as cattle are only able to go on to slaughter, back home, onto an approved holding and onto an exempt finishing unit. Dairy cows will still need to be tested.

Calves and Dairy Cows (in Gwilym Richards sale) must be kept separate from the finished cattle, so please make sure cattle are unloaded in the correct part of the market.

ARE YOU DEFICIENT?

Are newborn calves slow to rise and suck? Is it difficult to fatten calves on your land? Is the consumption of grain/hay/silage high? Is it difficult to keep the cattle in peak condition? Is your lambing percentage low? Is there a significant difference between scanning percentage and lambs to market? Do your lambs stand still after weaning? Is it difficult to finish lambs without creep? **Do you want your stock to grow healthier faster and cheaper?** If you do then you might need to retain the balance of trace elements to your ground. **To find out more please ring Jeremy Jehan on 07970 048080**
