A very short entry of strong ewes sold over £40 per head but the large entry of plain ewes reduced the overall average to £23.61. First quality ewes sold from £32, second quality sold from £20. Small and plain ewes sold to this figure. Rams sold to a similar trade to average £25.10.

45 REARING CALVES

A smaller entry of 45 rearing calves sold to a variable trade. Better quality calves sought after but 2nd quality and poorer calves finding fewer buyers. Top price for bulls was £200 for a Simmental with heifer to a top of £182 for a Limousin. Other heifer prices realised included £170 & £160 for Belgian Blues £160 Limousin and £130 Charolais, £80 Hereford cross. Other Bull prices; £160 Simmental, £165 Charolais, £138 Hereford cross and £132 Aberdeen Angus.
