STORE CATTLE REPORT

Sale Thursday 8th October 2009

An entry of 250 Store Cattle was well attended by prospective purchasers from a wide area. An excellent trade was experienced both on Stores and Suckler Cows and Calves. Suckler cows to £1,200 with others £1,000. Top price per head for Stores was £1,100 for a 600 kg heifer (183p per kg). Top price per kilo was 210p for 310 kg Charolais Steers (£650 per head). Other steers to £670 (189p per kg), £745 (186p per kg), £620 (193p per kg). Bulls to £710 (420 kg @ 169p per kg). The general run of Heifers to 168p per kg (£622) with many making over 160p per kg.
