A shorter entry of cattle for the green market resulted in a superb trade which was the dearest we have seen for over 10 years. Numerous cattle made over 150 pence with weight being no problem whatsoever. The entry was totally in sufficient for the demand and many more cattle could readily have been sold to advantage.
