An increased entry of ewes met another good trade. Once again best meated ewes sold over £50 with Beltex selling to the top price of £59. Another large entry of small and plain ewes but the overall average of £38.02 was very respectable. First quality ewes sold from £48. Second quality sold from £32, small and plain ewes sold to this figure. A larger entry of generally small rams averaged £34.40.

## 55 REARING CALVES sold on 14th August at 10.30 am

A larger entry of 55 rearing calves again sold to an excellent trade. Limousin weaned calves between 12-14 weeks made £390 per head for both heifers and bulls. Younger calves made to £300 for a Limousin bull calf with Belgian Blue to £220, £210 (twice), £205, etc. Charolais bulls to £210 (three times) with Simmental bulls to £190. Smart Friesian bulls to £70. Heifers keenly sought after to £220 for Charolais and another £205, Belgian Blue heifers to £205 (twice), £200 (twice) and £190 Limousin heifers to £205 and £195.
