A slightly reduced entry for the Christmas Show & Sale. The Champion Beast was exhibited by Mr Andrew Bishop and was sold to the Judge Mr Doug Willis for £250 pence (£1225.00), who also purchased the Reserve Champion, exhibited by Mr Adrian Cooke for 265p (£1711.90). There was generally a good trade on the 30 Show Cattle with all best sorts over 200 pence. The commercial cattle were of variable quality with several leaner and plainer consignments forward. Again best sorts sold well, in the 170 – 190 pence bracket. An entry of 26 Bulls sold to a very good trade with best sorts over 160 pence. MANY MORE CATTLE COULD HAVE BEEN SOLD TO ADVANTAGE.
