One of the largest entries of ewes for some time met a good trade but slightly less demand than the previous week. Once again the entry was of varied quality with a large number of small and plain ewes forward. Strong lean ewes sold to £82 with an overall average of £67.42 similar to the previous week. First quality ewes sold from £70, second quality sold from £55, small and plain ewes sold to this figure. An increased entry of rams met a similar trade to average £61.20.

60 REARING CALVES sold on Thursday 28th May

An increased entry of 60 rearing calves of improved quality sold to another excellent trade. British Blue bulls and heifers (twice) topped at £350 with other British Blue bulls £310 and £290. Other British Blue heifers £310 and £268. Limousin bulls to £320, Simmental bulls £228, Hereford cross bulls £300 and Friesian bulls £100. Simmental heifers to £300, Charolais heifers £300, £290 (twice) £280, Aberdeen Angus heifers £275, Blonde D'Aquitaine £232, Limousin heifers £270, £250, £245.

In the weaned-off section Charolais heifers to £410 and £400.
