REARING CALVES

A disappointing entry of 30 rearing calves sold to an excellent trade. No outstanding continental bulls forward but a small well shaped Limousin made £175 and a Charolais £170. Hereford Cross bulls in demand to £198, £190, £178, £155, £140, etc. Aberdeen Angus bulls to £172 and smaller ones £100. Heifers very dear to £190 for a Belgian Blue with Limousin to £155, Charolais £140, Hereford Cross £85, Aberdeen Angus £88. Weaned Limousin Heifers to £272 (5 months) and £200 (9 weeks)

23 DAIRY CATTLE

A surprisingly large Bank Holiday market entry with only the very best meeting spirited bidding which is not surprising considering the larger number of genuine on-farm dispersals in the region taking place before silage making commences. Heifers and cows sold to over £1000 - £1071 from GD & MK Parry, Abergavenny (cow), £1060 from ET Summerfield & Son, Oxford (heifer). Other calved heifers to £966, £903 (twice), £882, £850, £840 (three times), etc.

PRE-MOVEMENT TB TESTING

Please note we will still be holding alternative Red and Green Exempt Markets. This means that fat cattle attending a Green Exempt Market do not need to be pre-movement tested.

This exemption is allowed as cattle are only able to go on to slaughter, back home, onto an approved holding and onto an exempt finishing unit. Dairy cows will still need to be tested.

Calves and Dairy Cows (in Gwilym Richards sale) must be kept separate from the finished cattle, so please make sure cattle are unloaded in the correct part of the market.

OLDER CATTLE DISPOSAL SCHEME (OCDS)

The above scheme catering for all stock born before 1^{st} August 1996 is now in operation. A fixed headage price of approximately £250.70 (370 euros) before stoppages, will be payable for all animals fit for human consumption. Animals have to be correctly tagged and exactly match their paperwork. We are holding collections on a regular basis on a pre-booked system.
