A disappointing entry of ewes considering the demand in recent weeks met another flying trade. Once again strong lean ewes in short supply but those forward regularly sold over £90. Another exceptional overall average of £78.11 the highest seen in the market for some time. First quality ewes sold from £85. Second quality sold from £65. Small and plain ewes sold to this figure. A short entry of Rams also met a flying trade selling to £100 and average £78.50. Goats sold to £54 and average £50.94.

40 REARING CALVES sold on Thursday 17th February Sale at 10.30 am

An increased entry of 40 rearing calves sold to a good trade on the better quality calves but smaller and poorer shaped calves met little demand. Top price was £290 (twice) for Simmental cross heifer calves with British Blue heifers to £270, £240 and £230, etc. Limousin heifers to £250 and £200. Bull calves topped at £250 for Aberdeen Angus with Shorthorn bulls to £200, British Blue £195, Limousin £190 and Hereford cross £175. Next calf sale is Thursday 3rd March at 10.30 am.

ESCAPED LIVESTOCK PLAN

All farmers must secure the market gates to the gates of their trailers <u>each and every</u> time stock are loaded/unloaded. If this is not done you are liable for any damage caused by an escaped animal. Once you have finished loading/unloading these gates must be shut and secured. If an animal does escape please inform a member of staff immediately who will blow the 'Whistle'. This then warns the gate keeper to close the vehicle gates. Available staff will secure the market perimeter. Once secure, the escaped animal will need to be herded back into the market pens. (We may use quiet stock already penned to help catch the escaped animal).
