The largest entry of ewes seen in the market for sometime met a slightly less demand in line with the national trend. Once again strong meated ewes were in short supply but those forward sold over £70. Belted ewes sold to the top price of £88 leaving a satisfactory overall average of £60.21 considering the number of small, plain and mule ewes present. First quality ewes sold from £65. Second quality sold from £50, small and plain ewes sold to this figure. An increased entry of rams met a similar trade selling to £87 and average £67.97. Goats sold to £59.50 and average £56.82.

### 400 STORE CATTLE sold on Thursday 19th November

An excellent entry for the second November sale was competed for by a very strong contingent of buyers. A hightlight of the sale was an entry of cows and calves from WH Cook, Bredons Norton. These sold to large interest topping at £1820 for a Cow with Bull calf. Store cattle sold to a top price of £995 for a pen of Limousins from JH Goulding, Newent. Leading Prices on Steers: 590 kg £995, 525 kg £920, 425 kg £750, 510 kg £820, 330 kg £640, 325 kg £630, 275 kg £540, 225 kg £470. Leading Prices on Heifers: 490 kg £815, 530 kg £815, 455 kg £685, 420 kg £728, 425 kg £678, 280 kg £480.

# 40 REARING CALVES sold on Thursday 19<sup>th</sup> November Sale at 10.30 am

A lower entry of 40 Rearing Calves sold to an excellent trade. Top price was £370 for a British Blue heifer with Simmental heifers to £320 and small Limousins to £180. British Blue bulls to £350 with Limousin bulls to £340 and £310. Simmental bulls to £295 and £260 and Hereford cross £205. Friesian bulls to £70. In the weaned section 5 month old Limousin heifers to £410 and bulls £380. Next Calf Sale is Thursday 10<sup>th</sup> December at 10.30 followed by one on Thursday 17<sup>th</sup> December.

## LIVESTOCK ESCAPE PLAN

All farmers must secure the market gates to the gates of their trailers <u>each and every</u> time stock are loaded/unloaded. If this is not done you are liable for any damage caused by an escaped animal. Once you have finished loading/unloading these gates must be shut and secured. If an animal does escape please inform a member of staff immediately who will blow the 'Whistle'. This then warns the gate keeper to close the vehicle gates. Available staff will secure the market perimeter. Once secure, the escaped animal will need to be herded back into the market pens. (We may use quiet stock already penned to help catch the escaped animal).
