The Bank Holiday with fewer cattle forward saw a tremendous trade. In especially short supply were steers, only 34 forward averaged 144.13p/kg and £962.48, sixteen of which were over £1,000 per head up to £1152.57. Take out the Herefords and Simmentals the steers averaged 150p/kg @ 56% that makes them 267p/deadweight. Heifers were also a very strong trade, well up on last week, highs of 176p/kg and £1086.20. The only negative from today is cattle that were entered, but not shown – it is vital for us to have an accurate picture of numbers to match up to the buyers present. We will soon be trialing systems to benefit those who enter their stock. MONDAY 31ST MARCH IS A RED MARKET.
