All classes of cattle were in keen demand with a particularly good trade on heavier sorts. Several steers and heifers realised over £900 to a top of £915. Auctioneer: Martyn Evans An increased entry of ewes met a similar improved trade as the previous week. Once again several pens of strong ewes sold over £40 per head to an overall average of £33.28. First quality ewes sold from £38, second quality sold from £25. Small and plain ewes sold to this figure. Rams sold to £39 with an average of £33.25. A pen of goats sold to £24.

#### **90 REARING CALVES**

An entry of 90 rearing calves of varying quality sold to a good trade on the best. Top price for bulls was £220 for a Belgian Blue with others of the same breed £218, £200 (3 times), etc. Limousin bulls to £170 and £160. Hereford cross bulls £155. Blonde D'Aquitatine £160 and Aberdeen Angus £100. Heifers reached a high of £222 for a Belgian Blue with other Belgian Blue's £180, £175, £140, etc. Small Limousin heifers to £115 with Hereford cross £175 and £135. 6 month old Friesian bulls to £110.

Please note we are holding Green Exempt Markets. This means that fat cattle attending a Green Exempt Market do not need to be pre-movement tested.

This exemption is allowed as cattle are only able to go on to slaughter, back home, onto an approved holding and onto an exempt finishing unit. Dairy cows will still need to be tested.

Calves and Dairy Cows (in Gwilym Richards sale) must be kept separate from the finished cattle, so please make sure cattle are unloaded in the correct part of the market.

#### **ARE YOU DEFICIENT?**

Are newborn calves slow to rise and suck? Is it difficult to fatten calves on your land? Is the consumption of grain/hay/silage high? Is it difficult to keep the cattle in peak condition? Is your lambing percentage low? Is there a significant difference between scanning percentage and lambs to market? Do your lambs stand still after weaning? Is it difficult to finish lambs without creep? Do you want your stock to grow healthier faster and cheaper? If you do then you might need to retain the balance of trace elements to your ground.
