There were still 11 buyers around the ring but the real "fizz" seems to have gone with buyers all complaining of buyer resistance to high meat prices. The entry was highly variable with several good quality loads forward but at the other end of the scale a high percentage of plainer sorts. Best quality sold from 190 - 200 pence with heavier sorts again selling particularly well.
