A larger entry of lambs again sold to a firm trade which was ahead of the previous week. Best trade was on lambs over 41 kilos which peaked at **131.2 pence**. Numerous plainer lambs from 36-39 kilos reduced overall averages. Once again it was evident that well meated lambs sold to advantage. The overall average was £47/head which was £3 ahead of the corresponding market last year.

407 CULL EWES & RAMS

An increased entry of ewes met another good trade but slightly less than the flying demand of the previous week. Strong ewes regularly sold between £45 - £50 per head. A large entry of plain ewes reduced the overall average to £34.49. First quality ewes sold from £40, second quality sold from £28, small and plain ewes sold to this figure. A short entry of rams sold to £51 and averaged £39.20.

35 REARING CALVES

An entry to 35 rearing calves sold to a good trade although fewer buyers in attendance due to the improved weather. Top price was £210 for a Belgian Blue bull with Charolais bulls to £200 and Limousin bulls £190. Hereford cross bulls to £162, small Aberdeen Angus £105 and Friesians £70. Few quality heifers forward topping at £160 for a Charolais with Limousins to £140, Hereford cross £112 and Aberdeen Angus £52.

12 DAIRY CATTLE

AUGUST

Another terrific trade with commercial heifers peaking at £1,335 for AP Ractliffe, Gloucester, with others to £1,200, £1,175 from the same home. First quality heifers averaged £1,210, second quality £861, third quality £788. Cows to £1,050 twice for 2nd calvers from S Morgan & Sons, Hereford, and CM Stone, Gloucester. Many more could have been entered to satisfy the strong demand.

PRE-MOVEMENT TB TESTING

Please note we are holding Green Exempt Markets. This means that fat cattle attending a Green Exempt Market do not need to be pre-movement tested.

This exemption is allowed as cattle are only able to go on to slaughter, back home, onto an approved holding and onto an exempt finishing unit. Dairy cows will still need to be tested.

Calves and Dairy Cows (in Gwilym Richards sale) must be kept separate from the finished cattle, so please make sure cattle are unloaded in the correct part of the market.
