A slightly reduced entry of cattle following the continual fall in deadweight prices. Two major abattoirs are largely blamed for this fall in price but as long as farmers keep sending them cattle prospects are not good! The quality of the cattle was again variable with some good runs followed by plainer sorts. The trade was probably better on the best cattle which realized over 110 pence to a top of 117.5 pence. Premium Steers averaged 112.0p, Prime 97.2p and Others 90.1p. Premium Heifers averaged 110.0p, Prime 97.1p and Others 88.2p. The next Market on MONDAY 10<sup>th</sup> OCTOBER 2005 is a GREEN MARKET.
