A very short entry of cattle due to Bluetongue restrictions which came into effect from Midnight. All markets were reporting lower returns last week as demand generally weakened. There were several pens of plainer lambs, lacking meat, which proved more difficult to sell. The overall average was £55.05 (40.5 kilos).
