Numbers seem to be short nationally at present and as a consequence prices seem to be holding up quite well. On Monday we had a slightly improved entry of finished cattle which again were of variable quality. There is certainly resistance at the very top end but all best sorts realized over 180 pence. There was a particularly strong trade on plainer sorts with only a handful under 125 pence. Many more cattle could have been sold to advantage.
