An entry of 120 rearing calves of variable ages and quality. However all top quality calves in good demand with smaller and poorer quality calves less money than pre-restriction days. Top price £244 for a Charolais bull with another £228. Limousin bulls to £240 (twice) with others £220 (twice), £200, etc. Simmental bulls to £225, £202, £185 with Belgian Blue to £218, MRI bulls to £195, £190 and Hereford to £175, £165. Friesian bulls to £55. Heifers topped at £200 (twice) for Belgian Blues with others £185, £180, £170, etc. Limousin heifers to £150 and Charolais £145. Hereford cross heifers £138.

PRE-MOVEMENT TB TESTING

Please note we are holding Green Exempt Markets. This means that fat cattle attending a Green Exempt Market do not need to be pre-movement tested.

This exemption is allowed as cattle are only able to go on to slaughter, back home, onto an approved holding and onto an exempt finishing unit. Dairy cows will still need to be tested.

Calves and Dairy Cows (in Gwilym Richards sale) must be kept separate from the finished cattle, so please make sure cattle are unloaded in the correct part of the market.
