Over the past couple of weeks we have seen all the wholesalers trying to bring back their prices. With the consumer credit crunch taking effect sales are obviously going to be difficult. What the abattoirs cannot control, however, is the weakness of the pound and the fact that there are generally less cattle about. Today we had another entry of variable quality which sold to a ring full of bidders. The edge has certainly come off the trade with only best sorts realizing over 180 pence. Generally the trade was very much in line but poorer quality cattle are certainly reducing overall averages.

In spite of the outstanding trade of recent weeks there was a disappointingly low entry of hoggets forward. Nationally numbers are very short and with the weak pound stimulating exports the trade appears set to stay strong over the forthcoming weeks. The quality of the hoggets on offer today was much poorer than of late with a high percentage of lean numbers forward. Well meated belly shorn hogs sold particularly well. Again heavier sorts sold well with numerous pens from £80 to £86.50.
